Please attach the Adjacent Neighbor Consent Form to this application and check the box that you understand and have complied with the terms of this ordinance requirement. п If the requirements of Section 7-1-19 are not complied with, the City may revoke any permit granted and/or initiate prosecution for a civil infraction violation. A person who has been issued a permit shall submit it for examination upon demand by any police officer or code enforcement officer. Chicken enclosures are subject to all provisions of Section 13-1-144 (Keeping of Chickens as an Accessory Use). Notwithstanding the issuance of a permit by the City, private restrictions on the use of property shall remain enforceable and take precedence over a permit. Private restrictions include but are not limited to deed restrictions, condominium master deed restrictions, neighborhood association by-laws, and covenant deeds. A permit issued to a person whose property is subject to private restrictions that prohibit the keeping of chickens is void. The interpretation and enforcement of the private restriction is the sole responsibility of the private parties involved. All persons keeping chickens must properly dispose of manure by using it for fertilizer, removing it from the property, or working it into a compost bin or container. All stored manure shall be covered by a fully enclosed structure with a roof or lid over the entire structure. All other manure not used for composting or fertilizing shall be removed in a timely manner, and no accumulation in manure piles shall be allowed. In addition, all enclosures and the surrounding area must be kept free from trash and accumulated droppings. Uneaten feed shall be removed in a timely manner.
