

# SOLID WASTE AND BULK MATERIAL DISPOSAL

## LEAVES

The City of Plymouth will collect leaves raked on the boulevard each fall as always.

## OTHER COMPOSTABLES

### (Grass Clippings, Yard and Garden Waste)

No curbside pickup is provided. The City will provide a drop off site at the City Garage on Valley Road. Drop off site is available during normal working hours. From mid-April to mid-November the garage will be open on Saturdays. Hours are posted. It is recommended that you do not collect your grass clippings, but allow them to decompose on the lawn.

## BRUSH

No curbside pickup is provided. The City will provide a drop off site at the City Garage on Valley Road. Drop off site is available during normal working hours. From mid-April to Mid-November the garage will be open on Saturdays. Hours are posted. Special collection can be arranged at owners expense. Call the City Garage, 892-4925.

## BULK MATERIALS

Curbside pickup is NOT available for bulky items. For bulk items, contact a private hauler:

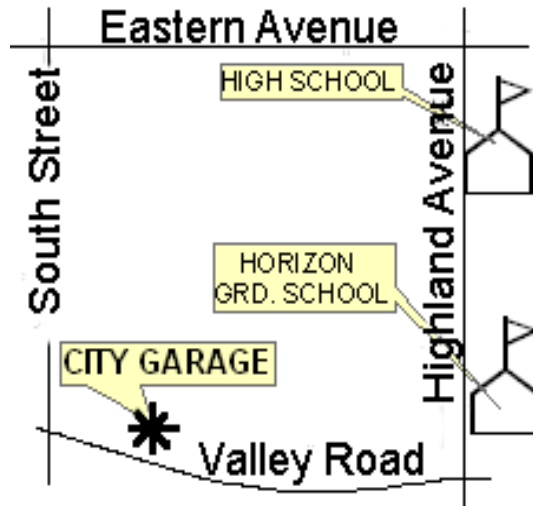

Construction, remodeling and demolition debris (roofing, siding, plaster, drywall, scrap lumber) will not be picked up by the city's hauler.

White goods with Freon (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers) will not be picked up by the city's hauler. The owner must contract a private hauler for these items.

White goods, non-Freon (washers, dryers and stoves) can be disposed of at the City Garage on Valley Road.

**Acceptable Plastics-** We accept all plastic # 1-7.



- #1 Plastic- Soda and Water Bottles, Peanut Butter and other food jars. – PETE.
- #2 Plastic- Milk Jugs, Juice Bottles, Yogurt Cups. –HDPE.
- #3 Plastic- Household Cleaner Bottles, Liquid Detergent Bottles. –PVC.
- #4 Plastic- Squeezable Bottles, Bread Bags, Plastic Wrapping.-LDPE.
- #5 Plastic- Yogurt Cups, Ketchup Bottles, Syrup Bottles. –PP.
- #6 Plastic- Meat Trays, Egg Cartons, Aspirin Bottles.-PS.
- #7 Plastic- Three and Five Gallon Water Bottles. –OTHER.

- ❖ When in doubt, throw your item in the garbage.
- ❖ Please be sure to rinse all plastic and metal containers to remove residue.
- ❖ If your area provides carts, all items must be placed in your cart to be collected.
- ❖ If your area has bagged trash, please use blue bags for recyclables.

Carts should be placed for pickup by 7:00 a.m.

- **Y**our cart should be within 18 inches of the curb with the arrows on the lid pointing to the street/curb. Carts cannot be placed on the street. If there is snow, please clear an area in the terrace, or leave the carts at the end of your driveway.
- **T**o avoid damage to property, place the cart at least three-feet away from mailboxes, lampposts and other fixed objects.
- **P**lace your cart on as level a surface as possible, but away from low hanging tree branches.
- **P**lace carts at least three feet away from each other.
- **C**lose lids prior to pick-up. Lids should be closed on the carts for driver identification and in order to stop material from spilling or blowing away.
- **C**arts not properly placed will be tagged and not picked up.
- **O**nly **Advanced Disposal Carts** will be emptied

Glass containers, aluminum cans & foil, tin & steel cans, plastics #1-7, newspapers, junk mail, magazines, cardboard, office paper, fiberboard (cereal & shoe boxes), phone books, books, and metal	Blue Cart	All recyclables must be placed in the blue cart. No loose items will be picked up.
Windows & mirrors, light bulbs, Pyrex & dishes, glasses	Gray Cart	All garbage must be placed in the gray cart. No loose items will be picked up.

Plastic oil bottles, Styrofoam, plastic cups, firm hard plastic (toys, pails, etc.)	Gray Cart	
Metal – bicycles, fences, bed frames, basketball hoops, grills, lawn mowers	Blue Cart - disassemble or break down to fit into the cart. Gasoline & oil must be removed from lawn mowers & disposed of properly.	If items do not fit in the cart, call Advanced Disposal 1-888-688-4005 for cost and to arrange for pickup. Refrigerator, air-conditioning units, microwaves, dehumidifiers	Do not place in a cart	Items must be picked up by a licensed hauler. Call Advanced Disposal, 1-888-688-4005, for cost and to arrange for pickup. Paint	Latex Paint that is dried up or empty cans – Gray Cart. Oil Based Paint – do not place in a cart.	Oil based paints are hazardous and must be disposed of properly.
