

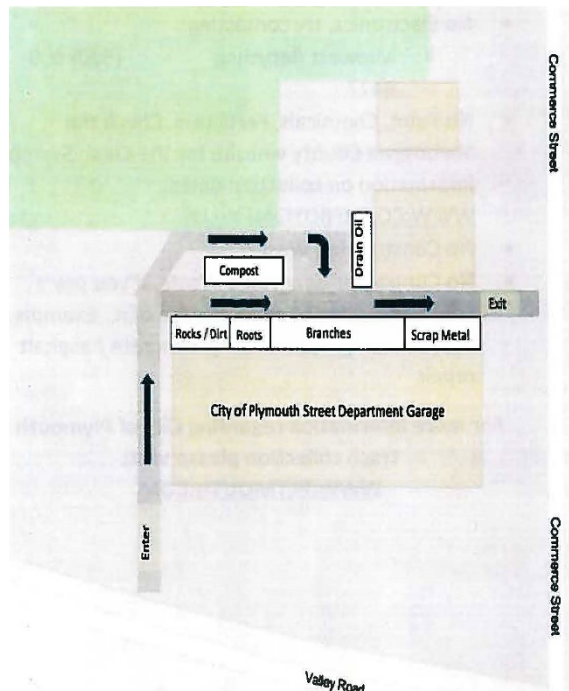

The City of Plymouth's Garage Drop Site is open to the residents of the city year around. Our purpose is to handle recyclable items, like yard waste, scrap metal, and waste oil. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us or ask one of our employees.

The entrance is on Valley Rd. and exit to Commerce St.



### **Materials Accepted at the City Garage:**

- Compost materials: grass clippings, leaves, perennials, fruit/seeds.
- Rocks, Dirt, & Concrete
- Roots - must be cut off.
- Scrap Metal:
  - Dishwashers, dryers, washers, grills, and other metals.
  - Car Batteries
  - **NO** electronics, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers.
  - **Glass Must Be Removed**

### **Materials Not Accepted at the City Garage**

- No Bulk Drop Off, use your garbage cans for disposal or try contacting:

- No Light Bulbs, try contacting:

- No Paint, Chemicals, Fertilizers. Check the Sheboygan County website for the Clean Sweep information on collection dates:

- No Construction Waste.
- No Contractor Generated Waste. If you pay a contractor, they need to dispose of it. Examples: tree trimming, lawn cutting, concrete/asphalt repair.
