

Plymouth Public Library Face-covering Policy

The Plymouth Public Library continues to prioritize the health and safety of our staff and community during this public health emergency. We continue to follow recommendations from the Sheboygan County Health Department, DHS, and the CDC. We recognize that wearing face coverings in public settings is one important way to slow the spread of COVID-19. Studies have shown people can spread the new coronavirus when they do not feel ill (pre-symptomatic or asymptomatic). Studies have also shown that widespread mask usage can exponentially slow the spread of the virus.

Library visitors will be required to wear a face covering that covers the mouth and nose at all times while inside the library for the duration of the COVID-19 public health emergency. A face covering could be a cloth mask, scarf, or neck gaiter.

If you are unable or uncomfortable wearing a mask in the building, the library will still offer curbside pickup of materials and encourage the use of online databases and resources.

The face-covering requirement will remain in place until social distancing guidelines are lifted by public health officials.
